VINEYARD INFO / REGION

Our grapes are grown on the slopes of the original Rancho Tolenas, the Mexican Land Grant spanning Napa and Solano Counties. Located just east over the Vaca mountains from Napa Valley, the Suisun Valley is the self-proclaimed "Petite Sirah Capital of the World."

Our red blend showcases the versatility of our little Suisun Valley, and how we can create balance and softness in our wines from many different varietals.

WINEMAKING / VITICULTURE

This Suisun Valley Red Blend is crafted from 50% Petite Sirah, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 20% Zinfandel. This blend is a fruit-forward, medium-bodied wine with notes of French and Hungarian oak. It comes together as a wine of its own, without any one varietal overwhelming the palate.

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of muddled dark cherry, dried blueberry, and exotic spices rise up from the glass. Full bodied with grippy tannin and boisterous acidity, this wine exhibits tremendous balance and natural complexity. The Suisun Valley Red Blend pairs with most foods and is a true crowd-pleaser.
